Proposed Replacement Activities:

**Supportive Needs Housing: \$503,153.10**

**Zebra Way Project:**

Up to 11 units of low-rise multi-family supportive needs housing for LMI homeless individuals and households to transfer to permanent housing from shelter or transitional housing. HOME funds are intended to be used to subsidize project development costs, including professional costs, other soft costs and construction costs. The project will also obtain funding from other sources and developer equity. Supportive needs services will be provided through other funding through local social service providers.

The project is located on Zebra Way in New Brunswick and is in walking distance to food stores, transit services, schools and social services.
