Two Juvenile Pedestrians Struck on Livingston Avenue

On Monday evening at approximately 6:38pm a mother and her three (3) children were crossing Livingston Avenue at the intersection of Wellington Place and Lawrence Street when the driver of a Toyota Camry struck two of the children and fled the scene. The two children struck by the vehicle were identified as a 14 month old female in a stroller and an 8 year old female walking alongside with her older sister and mother. The 14 month old received minor abrasions to her head and face and the 8 year old received a broken toe as a result of the collision. Both were treated at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital for the non-life injuries.

The driver of the vehicle was located approximately one (1) hour later by New Brunswick officers in North Brunswick. He has been identified as Brian Michael Smith (30 year old male from North Brunswick). This investigation is ongoing and charges are pending against Mr. Smith.
