On July 18, 2016 at 10:27 p.m., two Rutgers University students were robbed at knifepoint in the area of Hamilton Street and Division Street. One of the suspects brandished a knife as the other suspect entered the victim's pocket and removed a cell phone. The suspects then ran towards a silver vehicle that was waiting in the area of 175 Hamilton Street. This vehicle fled the area on Hamilton Street. Neither victim sustained any injury.

Members of the Major Crimes Unit conducted a follow-up investigation which identified three suspects in connection to this robbery. The two suspects that approached the victim and the driver of the getaway vehicle were arrested during the weekend of July 23, 2016 without incident.

Dauri Cabrera, a 19-year-old male from New Brunswick was charged with Armed Robbery, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery, Unlawful Possession of a Weapon (Knife), and Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose.

Michael Yensi, a 21-year-old male from New Brunswick was charged with Armed Robbery and Conspiracy to Commit Robbery.

Vincent Paley, a 21-year-old male from Old Bridge was charged with Armed Robbery and Conspiracy to Commit Robbery.
