Two Injured After Shooting at Throop Avenue and Delavan Street

On Monday evening at approximately 9:01 p.m. New Brunswick Police Officers responded to the area of Throop Avenue and Delavan Street to investigate a report of gun shots. Upon their arrival they located a gunshot victim, a 43-year-old male from New Brunswick. He was struck in the lower back and transported to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital and is listed in critical condition.

Responding units were also flagged down in the area of Livingston Avenue and Handy Street, where they were directed to a second victim, a 23-year-old female from New Brunswick. This female victim was found seated in the backseat of a vehicle and was transported by medic units to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital. She was struck in the chest and is listed in critical condition.

The New Brunswick Police Detective Bureau is actively investigating this incident. At this time there is no suspect identity or description. Anyone with information is asked to contact Detective Drew Weiss at (732) 745-5217.
